Saideh, another Victim



Saideh Poor Aghai, a victim of Islamic regime's savagery. After Taraneh Mousavi, a 27 year old who got arrested in the street and died due to rape and torture; report of Saideh's death in prison due to rape in Islamic Republic published.

Saideh who had lost her father in Iran, Iraq war, was arrested by the militia while shouting anti government slogans from the top of the roof. Regime forces informed her family of her death after 20 days that their daughter's body is at the morgue in Tehran. However, they refuse to let the family to take her body and secretly and without informing the family buried her at Tehran's graveyard (Beheshte Zahra).

They buried her body while eyewitnesses reported; her body was burnt by acid from knee up to cover-up rape injuries.

As we mentioned before, her body was buried quietly at Tehran's graveyard where according to reliable sources, majority of young adult women died due to rape and torture are buried.

Farshad Hosseini, Mina Ahadi, Shiva Mahboubi, Fareed Arman, Akram Beerovand, Saeed Partow and Fereshteh Moradi participated in the press

conference and discussed at length, the most recent as well as thirty years of crimes committed by the Islamic regime; those crimes include torture, rape, execution of minors and children, assassination of regime opposition members inside and outside Iran. Demonstrators who

In Iran, schools and universities will begin the new school year on September 21st. This means 18 days from today. forces on Khordad 24th (June 14th) 2 days after the election; 5 students were murdered during this attack. After this incident, Tehran university students along with students from other cities protested and condemned this savagery attack and demanded the arrest and prosecution of responsible parties. This also ended in student's interrogation instead.

On the other hand, during the past few years and based on an old tradition, the president travels to one of the Tehran universities to begin the new school year; however, during the past few years each time Ahmad Nejad has attempted to open the new school year at one of the universities; has faced students objections and forced to leave the ceremony, or face slogan such as "dictator president, you don't belong to university" and setting his pictures on fire. But this year the situation of universities differ from the previous years. Islamic regime more than ever is prepared to suppress the students

and is extremely concerned about young adult's protests. Installing overhearing devices along with security cameras, strengthening the suppressor forces inside the universities is one of many activities of the Islamic regime against the students.

Students can't go to classes and sit on chairs where they can smell the blood of their friends, they can't study at universities where they still smell the fire smoke set by the Islamic militia forces and where the murderer of their friends are still in charge of universities and are threats to other students.

Each year, September 21st is a beginning of new mobility and excitement in Iran's society. This year a huge movement and excitement of people in Iran is to overthrow the Stone Age government of execution and stoning. People are enthusiastic to see their ability and power to bring down the Islamic regime and to build a human based society with human dignity of 21st century, the nightmare

Until now, no official organization or authority has taken responsibility for militia forces behaviors, despite the fact that these forces have been attacking youngsters, university students, women, workers, teachers and nurses without being held responsible for their actions.

On the other hand, people also attack the militia forces and put them under pressure. These forces, whom are mainly bikers, run away after being attacked by people. People set their motorbikes on fire; also car drivers by making traffic in the streets block the biker's activities.

Another way of objecting is shouting anti government slogan from the rooftops or apartment windows. Every night at 22:00 PM, in majority parts of Tehran and other big cities in Iran, people continue with their protest by chanting anti government slogan such as "down with the dictator" and "down with Khamenei".

turned up at 2 p.m. braving the rainy weather, carried placards of images of those who lost their lives; they gathered to represent all the deceased, those who were tortured and raped by the regimes criminal officials, as well as the families of the victims and whose loved ones blood was spilled for the freedom of Iran, and finally the millions of Iranians whose wish is to prosecute the heads of the Islamic regime. A manifesto was also read by Hosseini, Ahadi, Moradi, Partow and Arman in Farsi, English and Dutch.

During the demonstration Mina Ahadi and Farshad Hosseini who represented the International Committee Against Stoning and International Committee

Against Execution met and held discussions and deliberated with officials from the ICC prosecution unit. Other than the presentation of a detailed report of the crimes committed by the Islamic Republic during the last thirty years, a request for an investigation of said crimes as crimes against humanity, by the ICC was also made. A separate report based on the recent crimes which consisted of a list of one hundred names of those who are known to have been killed during the recent months as well as the illegal and secret burials in mass graves was also presented to said ICC officials. The issue of the tortures performed on detainees in prisons, rapes of political prisoners were mentioned as

well. Ms. Ahadi and Mr. Hosseini also reiterated the nature and severity of the crimes perpetrated by the Islamic regime against humanity and explained that any delay or compromise in this matter, where a concrete and effective international action plan for halting this course of genocide, whatever the reason, will lead to the continuation of these crimes. Every day the ICC delays the investigation of these crimes, will be another day will be an extension for the criminals perpetrating said crimes. Today international organizations who head up the ICC's role is to stand as a buffer and is duty-bound to prosecute criminals and as such they must act swiftly in taking action

against those responsible for such atrocities. The request to prosecute the heads of that Islamic regime is the request of millions of Iranian and hundreds of thousands of plaintiffs, in either a personal, political or public form. The officials from the prosecution unit of the ICC responded with diligence and readiness in accepting the reports presented to them; therefore based on the presented information a file for the investigation of the leaders of the Islamic regime was opened and the case number will be provided on August 31st which will then be distributed. The officials from the prosecution unit also explained the legal methodology of the complaint process and in response stated that the accelerated steps taken against the Islamic regime was as a result of the large and continued complaints

against the government of Iran and as such immediate action will be taken to examine the evidence. The officials from the prosecution unit also added that additionally they are currently addressing four cases of crimes against humanity in countries such as Uganda, The Congo, Sudan and Central Africa. The International Committee Against Execution continues its activities to inform public opinion on the topic of the executions and the general crimes committed by the Islamic Republic.
